Eligibility Requirements

- This scholarship is open to applicants who are high school graduates from schools located in **Mason County** or who have completed their G.E.D. in Mason County.
- Applicants must have been residents of Mason County for at least one year preceding the date of the application. **Applicants need not be members of Emanuel Lutheran Church.**
- **This scholarship is intended to assist those students who are pursuing a vocational or technical education that will lead to an Associate's degree, a certificate, or a license** in the area of nursing, cosmetology, criminal justice, computer technician, electronics, welding, or other such career. **Those pursuing a Bachelor's degree are specifically excluded from consideration.**
- This scholarship is intended to financially assist those students who are responsible for funding the majority of their own educational expenses.
- All eligible applicants must demonstrate commitment to academic success and seriousness in their pursuit of higher education as demonstrated by their cumulative grade point average (GPA). A minimum of a 2.0 cumulative GPA in high school, or if currently attending college or a vocational or technical school, a 2.0 cumulative GPA in this school is required as a minimum qualification. **Your most recent high school / college / vocational school transcript must accompany this application.**
- The student must complete the attached application in full and legibly. If not, the application will not be considered.
- Scholarship awards are made for one year at a time, but past scholarship awardees may reapply in successive years for continuing higher education.
- All applicants who meet these criteria will be considered; however, scholarships are not guaranteed to all applicants.
