October is Baby Bottle Month! Feed a bottle to support families in our community.

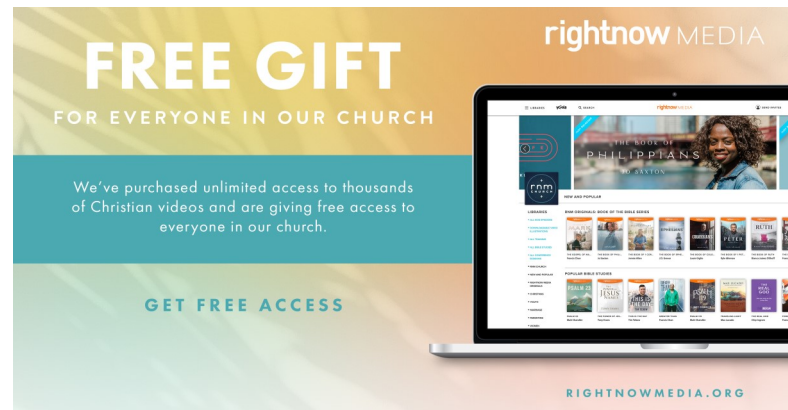


3 Ways to Give:

Sunday School for the 2020-21 School Year has begun!
