

2018-2019 Academic Year Application Sahlmark and Emanuel Lutheran Church Scholarships

Sahlmark Scholarship

This scholarship was established by Joseph Sahlmark, a former member of the Church, in 1967 to honor the memory of Esther E. Sahlmark. **Preference is given to those pursuing an education that will prepare them for a church-related vocation and/or who are attending or planning to attend a college associated with the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America (ELCA).**

Consideration may also be given to those attending other institutions of higher education. All applicants must demonstrate academic achievement.

Eligibility Requirements per Sahlmark Trust

- Open to high school graduates, those who have completed their G.E.D., or those enrolled in college who are **confirmed members of Emanuel Lutheran Church**
- **A member in good standing at Emanuel Lutheran Church** – meaning that you have communed at Emanuel **and** contributed financially to Emanuel within the last twelve months as per our constitution.
- All eligible applicants must demonstrate commitment to academic success and seriousness in their pursuit of higher education as demonstrated by their cumulative grade point average (GPA). **A minimum of a 2.0 cumulative GPA** in high school, or if currently attending college, a 2.0 cumulative GPA in college is required as a minimum qualification. **Your most recent high school/college transcript must accompany this application.**
- The student must complete the attached application in full and legibly. If not, the application may not be considered.
- Awards are made for one year at a time, but past scholarship recipients may reapply in successive years for continuing higher education towards a certificate, associates, bachelor's degree (up to five years) or graduate school.
- All applicants who meet these criteria will be considered; however, scholarships may not be awarded to all applicants.

Emanuel Lutheran Church Scholarship

This scholarship may be awarded annually to one or more individuals who have demonstrated commitment to Emanuel Lutheran Church by past and present involvement in activities such as Vacation Bible School, being a Sunday School teacher, participating in the music program (choir or instrumental accompaniment), youth group, etc..

- All of the requirements for the Sahlmark scholarship apply; in addition complete the section on the application form pertaining to the Emanuel Lutheran Church Scholarship.
- All applicants who meet the above criteria will be considered.

All scholarships will be awarded by June 1, 2018
